**ORDER**

Before Mr Justice Nicol sitting in the High Court, Queens Bench Division, on 14 March 2017;

UPON the Court having heard a contested committal application made by the Claimant on 13 March 2017 and having listed the matter for Judgment on 14 March 2017;

AND UPON hearing submissions from Counsel for the Claimant, and the First, Third and Fourth Defendants in person on 14 March 2017 following judgment;

AND UPON the First, Third and Fourth Defendants confirming that they are now aware of the terms of the injunction order of Mr Justice William Davis dated 21 February 2017 ('the injunction order');

AND UPON the Third and Fourth Defendants making an oral application to vary the injunction order with respect to paragraph 4 of the same, and the Court giving directions with regard to said application;

AND UPON the First Defendant having expressed a wish to make an application to discharge the injunction order insofar as it applies to him and the Court having made plain that he would need to make a formal application were he to wish to pursue the same;

AND UPON the Claimant (Council) confirming that it will not seek to enforce paragraph 4 to the injunction order at any time during the course of the application to vary mentioned herein, until such application is determined;

AND UPON it being confirmed to the Defendants that the injunction order continues to be in force;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT**

1. The Claimant's applications with respect to the Third Defendant and Fourth Defendant are dismissed;
2. The Claimant's application with respect to the First Defendant is withdrawn;
